## Year 12

### Topics Studied:

Unit 1: Law making and the legal system: Statutory Interpretation, The Civil Courts and other forms of dispute resolution and Judicial Precedent.

Unit 2: The concept of liability: Introduction to Criminal Liability and Introduction to Contract.

Unit 1 is predominantly delivered in the autumn term, with Unit 2 predominantly delivered in the spring term. There should be an opportunity for revision and final examination practice in the summer term before the examinations in May/June.

### Exam Board:

Year 12 students follow the AQA GCE in Law specification.

### Assessment structure:

Unit 1: 50% of AS (25% of A level) externally assessed unit.

Unit 2: 50% of AS (25% of A level) externally assessed unit.

Both external examinations will be taken in May/June of Year 12.

There is no controlled assessment or coursework.
