Topics Studied:

In AS French students study 4 main topic areas – Aspects of French-speaking society, Artistic culture in the French-speaking world and French cinema.

Students continue to develop their knowledge and understanding of French through the study of extended texts. They will study and review a film during the year and explore the key themes. An increased focus on grammar skills also enables students to become more independent linguists, with the confidence and ability to write extended pieces and to take part in detailed conversations in French.

Paper 1 – Listening, Reading and Writing exam – 45% of AS 90 marks
Paper 2 – Writing exam – 25% of AS 50 marks (film review and grammar)
Paper 3 - Speaking exam – 30 % of AS 60 marks (aspects of French society).
