### FULL - COLOURS

**Full Colours** are awarded to students that participate in 3 sports from Y7-Y12/13, allowing them to wear a special tie.

### LITERACY JUNIOR - COLOURS

**Lt** Junior Colours are awarded to students that read and review 3 books.

### HALF - COLOURS

**Half Colours** are awarded to students that read and review a further 3 books, and participate in 3 word of the week challenges (i.e. 6 books in total).

### FULL - COLOURS

**LITERACY** Full Colours are awarded to students that read and review a further 3 books and participate in a further 3 word of the week challenges (i.e. 9 books and 6 word of the week challenges in total).

### COMMUNITY HALF - COLOURS

**CSA** Half Colours are awarded to students that complete 20 hours of Community Service.

### FULL - COLOURS

**COMMUNITY** Full Colours are awarded to students that complete a further 20 hours (i.e. 40 hours in total).

### DRAMA HALF - COLOURS

**Dr** Half Colours are awarded to students that participate in 3 drama performances.

### FULL - COLOURS

**DRAMA** Full Colours are awarded to students that participate in a further 3 drama performances (i.e. 6 performances total).

### COMMUNITY - COLOURS

**COMMUNITY DRAMA** Colours are awarded to students for significant involvement in outside theatre, or drama school such as Brit Youth, Stage 2 and Stagecoach, or to students who have professional credits.

### DANCE HALF - COLOURS

**Dn** Half Colours are awarded to students that participate in 3 dance performances.

### FULL - COLOURS

**DANCE** Full Colours are awarded to students that participate in a further 3 dance performances (i.e. 6 performances total).

### COMMUNITY - COLOURS

**COMMUNITY DANCE** Colours are awarded to students for significant involvement in outside dance schools, or to students who have professional credits.

### MUSIC HALF - COLOURS

**M** Half Colours are awarded to students that participate in 3 music performances.

### FULL - COLOURS

**MUSIC** Full Colours are awarded to students that participate in a further 3 music performances (i.e. 6 performances total).

### COMMUNITY - COLOURS

**COMMUNITY MUSIC** Colours are awarded to students for significant involvement in outside music schools, ensemble performances or similar outside of school public performances, or to students who have professional credits.

### NUMERACY HALF - COLOURS

**N** Half Colours are awarded to students who complete 5 Numeracy or Mathematics activities.

### FULL - COLOURS

**NUMERACY** Full Colours are awarded to students who complete a further 5 Numeracy or Mathematics activities (i.e. 10 in total).

### HOUSE JUNIOR - COLOURS

**C K S W** Junior House-Colours are awarded, by Heads of House and Assistant Heads of House, to students that achieve **20 house points** for participating in, and contributing to, house activities.

### HALF - COLOURS

**Half House-Colours** are awarded, by Heads of House and Assistant Heads of House, to students that achieve **40 house points** for participating in, and contributing to, house activities.

### FULL - COLOURS

**Full House-Colours** are awarded, by Heads of House and Assistant Heads of House, to students that achieve **60 house points** for participating in, and contributing to, house activities.

### GOLD - COLOURS

### SIXTH FORM HALF - COLOURS

**6th** Half Colours are awarded to students that complete 15 hours of Sixth Form Responsibilities or Commitments.

### FULL - COLOURS

**SIXTH FORM** Half Colours are awarded to students that complete 30 hours of Sixth Form Responsibilities or Commitments.

### Y12 DEPUTY HOUSE CAPTAIN



The single **House Captain Band** is awarded to students that are appointed as Deputy House Captains by their Head of House and Assistant Head of House, following an application and interview process.

### Y13 HOUSE CAPTAIN



The second **House Captain Band** is awarded to students that are appointed as House Captains by their Head of House and Assistant Head of House, following an application and interview process.

### Y12 PREFECT

The single **Prefect Gold Band** is awarded to students that consistently attend their prefecting duties each week, to support the school routines.

\*\* The following bands are awarded to students that are appointed by the Headteacher, Deputy Headteachers, Head of Sixth Form and the Assistant Head of Sixth Form, following an application and interview panel process.

### Y13 SENIOR PREFECT

The second **Prefect Gold Band** is awarded to students that are appointed as a Senior Prefect.\*\*

### Y13 DEPUTY HEAD BOY/GIRL

The **Deputy Headboy or Headgirl Gold Band** is awarded to the two students that are appointed as Deputy Headboy and Deputy Headgirl.\*\*

### Y13 SENIOR DEPUTY HEAD BOY/GIRL

The **Senior Deputy Headboy or Headgirl Gold-White Band** is awarded to the two students that are appointed as Senior Deputy Headboy and Senior Deputy Headgirl.\*\*

### Y13 HEAD BOY/GIRL

The **Duo Headboy or Headgirl Gold Band** is awarded to the two students that are appointed as Headboy and Headgirl.\*\*
