RE: PHASED OPENING – YEAR 10 AND YEAR 12 STUDENTS

Further to my letter dated 22 May 2020, please allow me to provide the following update.

You may be aware of the government guidance on the re-opening of secondary schools and as such the timeline for contact has been amended.

The updated timeline is as follows:

- **Week commencing 1 & 8 June 2020:** work will continue to be set on Show My Homework for all year groups, as in previous weeks.
- **Week commencing 15 June 2020:** All Year 10 and Year 12 students invited into school for short pastoral meetings. Work will continue to be set on Show My Homework for all year groups.
- **Thursday 18 June 2020:** Academic Curriculum for Year 10 commences. Students from Year 10 will attend Fairfax Academy for some small group, face-to-face lessons on allocated days. Work will continue to be set on Show My Homework for all year groups.
- **Monday 22 June 2020:** Academic Curriculum for Year 12 commences. Students from Year 12 will attend Fairfax Academy for some small group, face-to-face lessons on allocated days. Work will continue to be set on Show My Homework for all year groups.

Please be advised that a personalised letter has now been posted home. This letter includes the details of when your child should attend school and also includes detailed guidance on the steps Fairfax Academy is taking to minimize risk and the steps you need to take to support your child. Could I kindly request that you read the letter in detail when it arrives.

I appreciate that this may be a time of anxiety for you and your child. Please be assured that the staff at Fairfax Academy are looking forward to welcoming students back and will do all they can to support students during this transition.
