Fairfax Examination Results 2019

We are celebrating another successful year of GCSE performance. Exceptional standards have been maintained across all core subjects. 84% of students achieved grade 4 and above in English, 78% achieved grade 4 and above in Mathematics and 78% of students achieved two Science GCSEs at grade 4 or above. In addition, an amazing 64 grade 9s were achieved by Fairfax Academy students.
