Water Fountain Use

A reminder notice: students are only allowed to use water fountains to replenish their personal water bottles. No other use is allowed. Students must wash or sanitize their hands before using a water fountain.

Wet and Cold Winter Weather

A reminder notice: as students are bubbled, and spend much of their time in the same classroom, we are keen to ensure that students are able to get outside and get some fresh air at break and lunchtime.

During wet and cold weather, we would ask that you **equip your child with a waterproof coat and/or umbrella** in order to ensure they are able to have a break outside. We know that being in the fresh air benefits well-being. If you have any concerns, please do not hesitate to contact your child's Assistant Head of Year or Head of Year.

In addition, as we move into winter, we will need to keep classrooms well ventilated and ask that students are sent to school with appropriate plain base layers and a black V-neck jumper. Hoodies are not acceptable and remain a prohibited item in school.

PE Lessons - Winter Months

A reminder notice: with the colder months ahead, we kindly remind parents that students are permitted to wear the following to keep them warm during PE lessons:

- Girls are allowed to wear black base layers underneath their PE skort and House polo shirt along with their black Fairfax fleece.
- Boys are allowed to wear long sleeved black base layer underneath their PE tops, and base layer black shorts under their shorts. Alongside this, the boys' mid layer is available at Clive Mark and Crested Schoolwear (Trutex Erdington).

A reminder notice: that students in Year 7 will have a slight change to their school day after half-term. Their break time will move from 09:55 to 10:35, and their lunch time from 12:15 to 12:45.

A reminder notice: that a Year 7 Parents' Evening will now take place on Wednesday, 4 November 2020. Due to Covid-19 restrictions this will not be a face-to-face Parents' Evening. A member of staff who teaches your child will call you on the telephone during the evening, between 15:45 and 18:45 to discuss how your child has settled in to Fairfax.

An advance notice: as a result of changes to the Year 8 bubbles, the Year 8 Parents' Evening in the Spring Term will now be over two evenings, Wednesday, 20 January and Wednesday, 3 February 2021.

A reminder notice: that students in Year 9 will be set following half-term. The teaching sets will allow teachers to plan lessons more sensitively matched to the group's ability. In addition, Year 9 will also become a year bubble, and this will mean that from Monday, 2 November, students will be able to purchase food from The Refectory at lunch time. The offer is limited but there are hot 'grab' options each day. There will be some changes to the Year 9 day in order to allow for five one-hour lessons with no interruption. The Year 9 break time will move from 09:35 to 09:55 and will be on the main playground. Lunch will move from 12:45 to 12:15 and will also be on the main playground.
