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Children are required by law to attend school 190 days per year and the Government advise that students' attendance should be at least 95%. However, 95% attendance equates to 10 missed days of school; a massive 50 lessons! Research has shown that students missing 20 days of school performed a whole grade lower in their exams than similar ability students with aood attendance.

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Wherever possible appointments should be made out of school time. We understand that at times appointments in the school day are unavoidable. Please provide evidence of the appointment in advance, so that we can amend our school records, and advise the school who will be collecting your child during the school day.
