Uniform Standards

A reminder notice that Fairfax is committed to encouraging students to be the best they can be. We are ambitious for our students and are encouraging them to maintain the highest standards, as this will prepare them for life beyond school, in which there will be rules, routines, and policies. We have high expectations of our students in all aspects of school life and we want them to be proud of their school and of their achievements.

It is important to us that students wear the correct uniform with pride. We have always had high standards at Fairfax, which is often cited as a reason for parents choosing Fairfax for their children. We want to maintain those high standards and are asking for your support with this.

We would kindly remind parents/carers to purchase any new uniform according to our uniform standards for September 2022, and to continue to check their child's uniform daily to ensure that full school uniform is worn, and that 'not permitted' items are not worn or brought to school.

Please ensure that your child has the correct uniform in September; particularly:

- Tailored trousers and/or skirts
- Jumpers must be V-necked and plain black
- Correct school tie, according to House and key stage
- Polishable black shoes

- No visible facial piercings (clear studs must be worn instead)
- Only one ear stud in each ear
- No painted/false nails
