 its your life not mine
- Listen and advise
- Help YOU make a well informed realistic decision.

My Role as a Careers Adviser?

- In school 3 days a week
 - -Wednesday Friday
- 1:1 guidance interviews
 - small office in the Library KNOCK and wait
- Interviews 30 minutes long
 - Informal chat with an action plan
 - Apologies as sometimes I do go over
 - You will be called for interview on the day and handed a slip with the time
 - Interviews will start towards the end of Sept
- referrals by SLT, HOY and Form Tutors
- Large number in school versus 1 careers adviser
- Also will be having meetings with 6th formers

What will YOU Choose?


Choose what's right for you?

- Alevels- more written work with final exam Now linear which means it's a straight 2 year course
 If you are predicted 3/4s then Alevels may not be for you
- Diplomas (Tlevels & Btec) Career related qualifications more practical and coursework based (Tlevels – more academic Btec- more course work based)
 - Level 3 Extended diploma = 3 Alevels can still move into Uni
- Industry Qualifications AAT, Children and Young Peoples Workforce, Motor Vehicle, Hair and Beauty, Construction
- Apprenticeships earn and learn –different levels
- Traineeships— Extended work experience stepping stone into an apprenticeship

You want to aim to get a good range of GCSEs to open more doors for you

What are your Post 16 Options?

Not your History, German, Art or DT *options* but the <u>options</u> available to you after Year 11



How to Decide

- Chose the course that's right FOR YOU start researching courses on school/college websites
- It's a Career Journey don't worry too much if you keep changing your mind - its part of the process
- IF UNDECIDED
 - use My Career Springboard or SACU
 - Produces list of career suggestions
 - More details in the library including passwords
 - Looking at the college websites
 - Read about the different courses and their levels
 - Look at entry requirements
 - Where they can lead
 - Think about how best YOU learn A levels versus Btec

Important pieces of information

- School is the only place you can take a wide range of GCSEs
- There is only provision to resit 'set' GCSEs
- If you do not pass your Maths and English at grade 4 or above then you will need to resit up until you either get the grade or you are 18.
- A back up plan is not just applying to another 6th form that has the same entry requirements as Fairfax.
 - A back up plan is a course at the same level but with lower entry requirements eg Btec or other A levels
- The only place this side of the city to do A levels other than a school 6th form is Sutton Campus or Landau Forte in Tamworth

What you need to achieve?

For Fairfax 6th form

We offer a range of Alevels and Btec qualifications Entry:

5 GCSEs grades 9-4 including English & maths

Subjects you wish to study

Subject specific grades are required – range from grades 5-7 depending on subject.

Also

- if you have not studied the subject before then a 5 in English/maths is needed
- For Physics, Chemistry and Maths you need grade 7s
- For Btec courses grades 4's are accepted apart from Applied Science where you need grade 5
- Remember Fairfax is an ACADEMIC 6th form
- Look at 6th form prospectus on the school website

APPLICATIONS OPEN - DAY AFTER 6TH FORM OPEN EVENING
ON TUESDAY 8TH NOVEMBER

What you need to achieve?

For other 6th forms and College

- Need to check entry requirements for each individual 6th form and college as they will all differ slightly.
- Grammar school will be looking at 7, 8 & 9s
- Some operate a point system ie Vesey require 52 points to get into their 6th form – more info on their website
- Work out your scores from your predicted grades set yourself a goal
- College will offer a wider range of courses including full Technical Diplomas such as T levels, Btec's and OCRs

Check out their websites for the range of courses.

When do I apply for Sept 2023 place?


- Fairfax Wednesday 9th November
- Grammar school
 - Have very early open days
 - Close their applications early
 - Check each of their websites
- Other 6th forms
 - Usually before Christmas –
 PLEASE CHECK THEIR WEBSITES
- Colleges
 - Like applications before Christmas although their applications run up until September
 - Apply early to secure your place
