We believe at Fairfax that no girl should be in period poverty. We have a large range of free sanitary products including some period pants that girls are welcome to. They are kept in Student Support and we give them out to students discreetly. Please can you kindly remind your child where to get sanitary towels and tampons from if they need them. In addition to this, we have a small supply of knickers and tights. We are however running low on these. If you are in a position where you are able to purchase a pack of black knickers/tights that we can give to our girls as they need them, please can you send them to Mrs Williams.

# Mobile Phones Reminder

Mobile phones should not be seen or heard once pupils are on the school site. Students should ensure phones are switched off before they enter the school gates and only switched on once off the school site. Where a mobile phone is seen or heard, the mobile phone will be confiscated and handed into reception and follow the procedure below:

- 1st confiscation text message sent home informing parents of confiscation. Student can collect their phone from reception after their detention.
- 2nd confiscation text message sent home informing parents of last chance. Student can collect their phone after their detention.
- 3rd confiscation parents receive a phone call requesting them to pick up the phone from school. Student will not be allowed to collect from reception.

The escalated procedure restarts at the start of each half term.

## **Punctuality**

A reminder notice: all students are expected to be on school site from 08:25 and be in their tutor room for registration by 08:30 each day. Any student arriving after this time will be considered late to school. Students who arrive after 09:15 without a valid reason, e.g. medical appointment, will be recorded as an unauthorised absence for the AM session only. To notify us that your child will be late to school, please telephone 0121 378 1288, press option 1 and leave a voicemail stating a valid reason for the lateness. We ask for your support in reminding your child of the importance of punctuality and the need to ensure enough time is given in order to travel to school each morning. Please be reminded that the third instance of lateness, and any lateness after this during a half term, will result in a 60 minute after-school detention.
