
SEND Update

Mobile Phones Reminder

Mobile phones should not be seen or heard once pupils are on the school site. Students should ensure phones are switched off before they enter the school gates and only switched on once off the school site. Where a mobile phone is seen or heard, the mobile phone will be confiscated and handed into reception and follow the procedure below:

- 1st confiscation text message sent home informing parents of confiscation. Student can collect their phone from reception after their detention.
- 2nd confiscation text message sent home informing parents of last chance. Student can collect their phone after their detention.
- 3rd confiscation parents receive a phone call requesting them to pick up the phone from school. Student will not be allowed to collect from reception.

The escalated procedure restarts at the start of each half term.

A reminder notice: parents/carers are kindly reminded that Fairfax Academy cannot authorise holiday leave during term time. Please be advised doing so may result in penalty charges.

Punctuality

A reminder notice: all students are expected to be on school site from 08:25 and be in their tutor room for registration by 08:30 each day. Any student arriving after this time will be considered late to school. Students who arrive after 09:15 without a valid reason, e.g. medical appointment, will be recorded as an unauthorised absence for the AM session only. To notify us that your child will be late to school, please telephone 0121 378 1288, press option 1 and leave a voicemail stating a valid reason for the lateness. We ask for your support in reminding your child of the importance of punctuality and the need to ensure enough time is given in order to travel to school each morning. Please be reminded that the third instance of lateness, and any lateness after this during a half term, will result in a 60 minute after-school detention.

Detentions

A polite reminder that schools and academies have the right to detain students for breaches of the School Behaviour Policy. Schools do not have to give parents/carers notice of after-school detentions or tell them why a detention has been given.

PE Lessons - Winter Months

A reminder notice: with the colder months ahead, we kindly remind parents that students are permitted to wear the following to keep them warm during PE lessons:

- Girls are allowed to wear black base layers under their House polo shirt, along with the optional mid layer
 - N.B. the black base layers should be a long sleeved top and base layer leggings (no fashion leggings permitted)
- Boys are allowed to wear a long sleeved black base layer underneath their PE tops, and base layer black shorts under their shorts. Alongside this, an optional mid layer is permitted.

PE Lessons – Footwear

Please be reminded that school shoes are not to be worn as PE trainers within PE lessons. Outdoor trainers should be worn in line with the Academy's Uniform Policy. Consequences will be issued to students who do not comply.

Aerosols Reminder

A reminder notice: aerosols are NOT permitted in school. Students should not bring in aerosols to use in PE and instead, if they require additional deodorant or anti-perspirant during the school day, a roll on can be used. There are a number of students in school with asthma, whose triggers are aerosols, and the use of aerosols can and will lead to a severe asthma attack. Any aerosols used/found in school will be confiscated and taken to student support. A confiscated aerosol will need to be picked up by the student at the end of the day. Careers Update

On Friday, 13 October 2023, we hosted a Year 13 Mock Interview event in the Library. Over 50 students volunteered to attend an interview, delivered by Birmingham City University, Nottingham Trent University, South & City College, University College Birmingham or University of South Wales. The feedback from students was overwhelmingly positive, as they were given the opportunity to hone their interview technique. Comments such as "I think this experience was extremely beneficial" through to "It has given me more confidence" and "It has taught me how to structure my answers to questions" were mentioned in the feedback from the students. It was an exceptionally helpful event with all students walking away with smiles and feedback sheets from the interviewers. Birmingham City University commented "that they were impressed by the students' experiences and how they presented themselves."

Mock and practice interviews are held each year for students in Year 13 and Year 11 respectively. The idea and aim is to help our students to be prepared for not only university interviews but also the working world. Our next practice interviews for all of Year 11 will be taking place on Thursday, 30 November 09:00-13:25. Next week Year 11 students will be participating in 'Futures Week'. A range of providers are coming into school to deliver assemblies to ensure students are aware of their options post 16. The finale will be the annual Career Fair on Friday, 27 October 2023. Year 9-13 students will be invited into the hall to speak with colleges, training providers, universities and employers.

All of our career activities are designed to give our students the opportunity to hear about different courses, apprenticeships or opportunities available to them once they leave school.
