RE: UNIFORM STANDARDS

As we move through Spring Term, we would like to take a moment to thank you for your continued support in upholding our school uniform standards. The majority of our students are wearing the correct uniform, and we are especially grateful to the many families who ensure their children arrive at school dressed correctly and appropriately each day.

We would, however, like to remind all parents and carers of the specific expectations regarding the appropriate style and wear of school trousers, as we have noticed a small number of students wearing items that do not meet our uniform policy.

If students wish to wear trousers, they must be of a tailored style, which does not include very tight-fitting trousers made of legging/ stretchy material. Trousers also must be worn around the waist and not lower.

Students wearing the Fairfax skirt continue to look smart, and the number of uniform-related detentions has significantly reduced since the introduction of the branded skirt. A polite reminder that students may wear one set of stud earrings and a watch (not a smart watch). No other jewellery is permitted.
